STUDENT MINIMUM ADMISION REQUIREMENTS: 2025

Madzivhandila College of Agriculture is an equal opportunity educational institution and as such does not discriminate in its admission policy on the basis of race, colour, gender, age or creed. Candidates interested in enrolling for the diploma programs at the college have to complete and forward application forms. Applications will be accepted from prospective candidates from all the provinces in the country. Applications for admission often exceed the available space, so admission to the College cannot be guaranteed.

1. APPLICATION INFORMATION

To become a student at Madzivhandila College of Agriculture the following admission procedures must be followed:

- **1.1**. Candidates who want to enroll for a diploma program at Madzivhandila College of Agriculture must apply in writing for admission and complete an application form.
- 1.2. A completed application form must be accompanied by the application (administration) fee as follows:
 Application fee (in time) : R 160.00 (Non-refundable)
 Late application fee: R 200.00. (Non-refundable)
- **1.3.** Application fee should be deposited in the following Bank account.

1.4. A deposit slip must be attached to the returned application form as proof of payment of application/administration fee. (*Applicants are advised to keep a copy of the slip in case the slip gets lost along the way*)

1.5. The following documents should be attached to the application form

- i) Certified copy of Grade 12 Certificate (if the applicant has already matriculated) OR certified copy of Grade 12 latest report (if the applicant is currently in Gr. 12)
- ii) Certified copy of Identity document of applicant
- iii) Certified copy of Parent or Guardian's Identity (id) document
- iv) 1 endorsed ID photo (colour)

1.6. The closing dates for the submission of applications are as follows:

The closing date (Late application): 31 January 2025 (only applicable if there is still space available)

Final Submission of Grade 12 results should be as soon as they are released (*date to be determined by announcement of release by Department of Education*)

2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DIPLOMA IN AGRICULTURE

2.1. The college has its own admission criteria which it uses in considering applicants for admission. The college offers two full time, 3 year Diplomas in two specialized fields:

2.1.1 Diploma in Agriculture: Plant Production (for complete programs,

2.1.2 Diploma in Agriculture: Animal production see page 4)

2.2. Admission Requirements for the Diploma in Agriculture – After 2009 (or applicants who have attempted the New Senior Certificate (Grade 12)

The minimum academic requirement for entrance to the College for applicants who attempted the New Senior Certificate (i.e. after 2009) are as follows:

- i) A National Senior Certificate with an average achievement rating of level 3 (i.e. 40% or better).
- ii) A compulsory achievement in specified subjects as follows:
 - English with at least Level 4 (i.e. 50-59%);
 - Mathematics with at least level 2 (i.e. 30% & above) or Maths Literacy with at least level 5 (i.e. 60% & above) – Take Note that those with Mathematics will receive first preference and will be admitted first before those with Maths literacy.
 - One of the following subjects with at least Level 3 (40-49%):
 Life Sciences, Physical Science, Agriculture Science or Geography.
- iii) At least **20 points** on the Admission Points Score (APS) System as follows:

2.3 Admission Requirements for the Diploma in Agriculture - Prior to 2009 (or applicants who attempted the old Senior Certificate (Matric)

The minimum academic requirement for entrance to the College for the applicants who attempted the old Senior Certificate (Matric) (i.e. prior 2009) are as follows:

- i) Senior Certificate or equivalent qualification, with an overall standard grade pass.
- ii) A compulsory achievement in specified subjects as follows:
 - English with a Higher Grade E;
 - Mathematics with a minimum Higher Grade F or Standard Grade E;
 - One of the following subjects with a minimum Higher Grade E or Standard Grade D: Life sciences, Physical Science, Agriculture Science or Geography.
- iii) At least **20 points** on the Admission Points Score (APS) System as follows
